## A Northcliffe Weather Station ...Postscript

Since our article about Weather information for Northcliffe, in October 2013, NCRC Secretary Jo Tat has made an interesting discovery. The Department of Agriculture and Food (DAFWA) has recently installed 40 new automatic weather stations across WA. Northcliffe was included in the roll out which was funded with assistance from the Royalties for Regions program. The weather data is updated every 10 minutes and the data from all 83 weather stations in operation is accessible from the DAFWA website at the following link:
