What a year it has been...

Throughout the year we have met many new Northcliffe residents. It always brings us pleasure to provide support to new and old community members and visitors, and to provide a friendly, warm welcoming space where the community feels safe, connected and social.

Our AGM will be held at 5pm on the 8th of December. All members are welcome or, if you can't attend, please sign a proxy form for us. Proxy forms were mailed out to members with spares available at the NCRC. All reports will be presented at the AGM.

Highlights from our Chairman's report...

We had 3903 people through the door in 2022/23. We have 107 paid up memberships. We provided 207 oneon-one support sessions plus lots of incidental support to people. We employed 3 trainees at different times during the year with 2 of these now graduated. We worked with many community partners on events like The Stars Descend and 25 Years of the Bibbulmun Track. The bean bag cinema has been in use more than ever and we hope to continue our screening program in 2024. Our Youtube channel had 685 views during the year with our first episode of The Northcliffe naturally Show attracting most of those. All our meeting rental spaces are currently in heavy use with 135 room book-

ings and 51 video conferences for the year. Another achievement was the installation of all new backend network technology to support our high speed internet and wifi, and a new file server and backup system.

Over the coming months we will be completing the upgrade of our systems by replacing and upgrading older customer facing computers.

Highlights from the Manager's report...

The Manager highlighted the more challenging parts of the year such as the application for charitable registration with the ACNC, new auditing and reporting requirements, Bankwest's curveball of closing down all our bank accounts, and the overly complication grant application system which supports our employment of trainees and ability to upgrade the CRC.
