## New Mobile and Tablet Friendly Northcliffe Websites...

Northcliffe Community Resource Centre has a new website!

On 31 December 2015 our old [northcliffe.crc.net.au](http://northcliffe.crc.net.au) website taken down, a decision of the State Government who were managing standardised websites for CRCs throughout WA. Grants were provided to all CRCs to develop their own replacement website and ours is now online. Our thanks to Royalties for Regions and the WA State Government for their work on the old websites and their assistance with this transition.

In redesigning our website we combined it with our long term effort to redevelop the Northcliffe Community Website at [northcliffe.org.au](http://northcliffe.org.au), a project which is very close to completion. This popular Northcliffe website was created within the old 'Telecentre' and was maintained for many years by local volunteer Kate Haslam on behalf of the NCRC. The website is now maintained from the NCRC and our trainee, Damon, actively updates the information.

The more eagle eyed may notice that the Contact page and Resources

page on this website resemble your new CRC webpage. This is because we are gradually moving the entire website to this new design. Advantages of the new design include that it has a highly flexible, mobile and tablet friendly display.

Other improvements with the website are easier maintenance, a fresh consistent look across and within pages, and consolidation of the content and computer code which has accumulated on this website over a fifteen year period.

This will be the first major redesign of this website which we know of. Over the past twelve months we have been preparing for this by ensuring all the most used content is up to date and accurate.

As we move over to the new website we plan to keep all of the important content online. In some areas content will be consolidated. We know people make regular use of our lists of Northcliffe businesses, accommodation, community groups and services and this information will continue to be available.

Once all the webpages have been replaced we will have a launch celebration. All going well, this will be in late February.
