Missing mobile phone calls?

Here's how to extend the ring time on your mobile phone *on the Telstra network.* Similar but different instructions apply for Optus or Vodaphone users.

By default Android and iPhones will ring for 15 seconds before diverting to voice mail. Is this a setting designed for big cities so you don't hear all the mobile phones constantly ringing on trains and buses, in restaurants and the like?

Here's how you can give yourself **30 seconds** to get to the phone. The instructions are almost identical for iPhones and Android phones (beware-if you have call forwarding turned on this will reset it).

EXTEND YOUR MOBILE PHONE RING TIME

First open your phone dialler, just as you do when you make any phone call. You need the number keypad:



phone symbole you should then see an onscreen message a bit like this:

"MMI code started... Call forwarding registration was successful"

Check your new settings are working by making another call:

*#61# Dial



You should see an onscreen message a bit like this: "Call forwarding... Sync: +61101 after 30 seconds."
