

Should I upgrade to Windows 11?

It is best to avoid major Windows upgrades for a few months, so that any teething problems get ironed out. Now that Windows 11 has been released for 12 months, is it time to make the change?

Factors to consider:

- If you have Windows 7, or a pre-2015 computer, forget it.
- There aren't pressing reasons to upgrade. Windows 10 is supported until October 2025.
- Laptops are trickier to upgrade than desktop computers.
- Windows 11 tries to insist you have a Microsoft Account. If you don't like this it might be best to stay away.

If you think you want to try it:

Download and run Microsoft's PC Health Check App to find out if your computer will run Windows 11:
microsoft.com/windows/windows-11#pchealthcheck

If you get all green ticks after ticking "Check Now" then you can proceed with a free upgrade.

- Backup your important data before proceeding.
- Set aside plenty of time and don't interrupt once underway.
- You can restore Windows 10 for the first 10 days, if desired.
