Search Tips



#1 Using Quotation Marks

If there is a specific phrase you want to you search for place it in quotes and Google will search for only those words in that exact order.

#2 Eliminate the Unwanted

If you are getting too many results that are of no interest to you, you can use the minus or hyphen sign (-). So if you were looking for a jaguar but you weren't interested in cars you could type in: jaguar -car.

#3 Tabs

At the top of a Google search result page you can usually see the tabs: All, Images, News, Video, and Maps. Give these a try. We often use the Images tab to identify by sight a device, when we need to find out the model number of (for instance) a troublesome Telstra modem.
