Our traineeship is a part-time job (21 hours per week) which you will work for 18 months. You will be paid for both the hours you work and the hours you study. At the end of 18 months, all going well, a supervisor from TAFE will sign off on your studies and you will receive a Certificate in Business or a Certificate in Tourism. These are nationally recognised qualifications you can use to get a job, or to gain entry to more advanced studies.

Eight trainees have graduated from the Northcliffe CRC so far. Many have since found jobs which suit them, through the connections they made at the NCRC, or through the skills and experience they gained.

If you want to find out what the life of a trainee is like come and visit Brayden, Damon or Cat at the NCRC. Brayden is our current trainee and Damon and Cat are previous graduates.

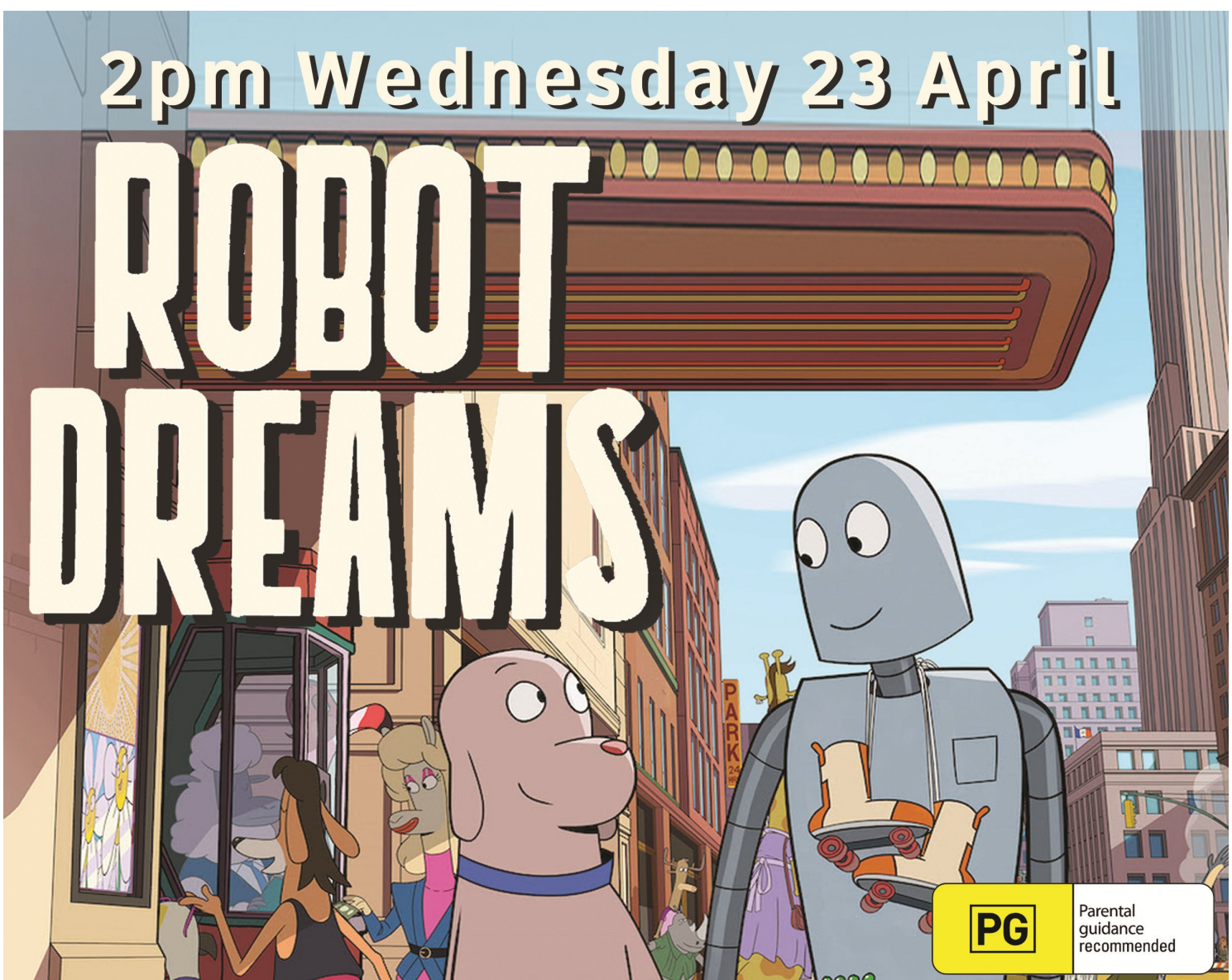
Before joining us, our trainees come from a variety of backgrounds and have begun with a huge variety of different experience and skill levels, and interests. This could be you!
