After a relaxing 9 day break the Northcliffe CRC is open again at our usual times. And while we may be jealous of the masses enjoying the sunshine at Windy we are very much appreciating our air conditioning.

Our Westnet ADSL has been holding the CRC back for many years. So, while we waited for Starlink, we decided to upgrade to a Telstra Mobile Internet solution.

So far it's great. Our download speed is about 5 times faster and our upload speed is about 30 times faster! The results in the image are from this new internet connection.



All CRC users, and those using our wifi hotspot, will now enjoy much faster internet. Performing youtube uploads, uploading photos and videos, and performing icloud backups, will now be possible. We should also have a better experience if we are inundated by kids all wanting to get online at the same time, in the coming school holidays.

Our internet will improve again, by an order of magnitude, once the Starlink connection arrives. Sadly, we recently found out our Starlink internet connection would be delayed by up to 12 months. The company is having trouble building enough customer equipment to fulfil around 1 million sign ups.

Starlink is a new internet technology being rolled out across the world, to deliver world class internet speeds to remote locations everywhere on earth.
